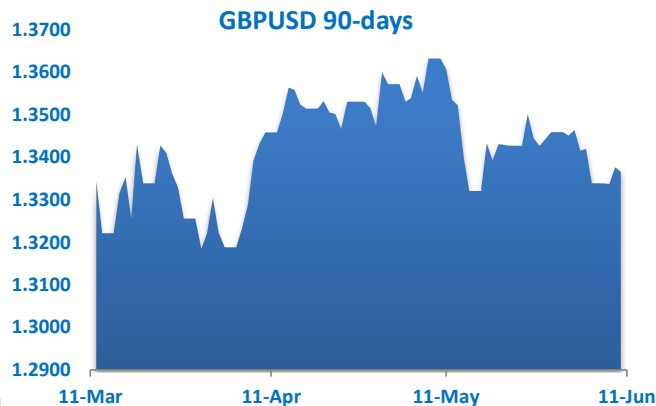

US STOCKS-Wall Street indexes fall more than 1%, hit by tech, Iran war worries

- The major U.S. stock indexes ended more than 1% lower on Wednesday, with chipmaker shares extending recent declines and with renewed tensions between the U.S. and Iran adding to investor uncertainty.
- The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 953.33 points, or 1.87%, to 49,918.78, the S&P 500 lost 119.66 points, or 1.62%, to 7,266.99 and the Nasdaq Composite lost 509.32 points, or 1.98%, to 25,169.50.

Dollar shaky as investors weigh rate outlook, Middle East worries

- The U.S. dollar wobbled on Thursday as new U.S. strikes in the Middle East undermined sentiment, while a surge in May U.S. consumer inflation to a three-year high kept investors uneasy about the Federal Reserve's monetary policy outlook.
- The dollar index, which measures the U.S. currency against six major peers, eased to 99.903 after U.S. military said it has completed strikes against multiple targets in Iran. The euro bought \$1.1553, inching away from the 10-week low it hit last week, but has given up most of its gains since a ceasefire was struck in early April.

Oil rises more than \$1 as escalation in US-Iran strikes unnerve traders

- Oil prices jumped as Tehran declared the critical energy chokepoint, the Strait of Hormuz, closed after the U.S. launched additional strikes against Iran and as President Donald Trump vowed even more attacks if no peace deal is secured.
- Brent futures rose \$1.48, or 1.59%, to \$94.58 a barrel as of, while U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude climbed \$1.71, or 1.90%, to \$91.74. U.S. crude futures gained more than \$3 earlier in the session.

PRECIOUS-Gold steadies after hitting six-month low; inflation data in focus

- Gold prices steadied after hitting a six-month low on Thursday, as investors awaited a key U.S. inflation report that could shed more light on the Federal Reserve's policy outlook.
- Spot gold rose 0.1% to \$4,077.39 per ounce after hitting its lowest since November 21 at \$4,022.09 earlier in the day. U.S. gold futures for August delivery were down 0.8% at \$4,098.90.
